

## **Will the use of LUBEGARD void my Vehicle warranty?**

The use of Lubegard will not void your warranty. Nor will the use of any consumer product that is not an Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEM) product (also known as an aftermarket product) in the United States void any type of warranty.

Under the Magnuson-Moss Warranty Act and general principles of the Federal Trade Commissions Act a manufacturer may **not** require the use of any brand unless the manufacturer provides the item **free of charge** under the terms of the warranty.

Basically if a consumer is told that only the OEM product will not void the warranty, that consumer should request the OEM product to be supplied free of charge. If the customer is refused or charged for the OEM product the customer should ask for a copy of the warrantor's approved FTC waiver if this is not supplied the manufacturer will be violating the Magnuson-Moss Warranty Act or other applicable law.

For example;

If you wanted to add Lubegard HFM-ATF Supplement with Dexron/ Mercon to your transmission that requires a highly friction modified ATF (such as OEM ATF's Honda Genuine, Chrysler Mopar ATF +3 (7176) Mopar ATF +4 (9602), Toyota Type T, TII or TIV etc.), would it void the warranty on your car?

**No. Absolutely Not!**

If you wanted to install any type of aftermarket product to a OEM make, would it void the warranty on that OEM make?

**No. Absolutely Not!**

Remember....it's your choice as a consumer! And, it's the law.
